

2013 Rulebook Amnesty

27 September 2012

All competitors are to be advised that there will be an amnesty period until the 1st January 2013, to allow for full compliance to several new rules introduced in the 2013 rulebook.

The amnesty is to assist racers and reduce complications that may be experienced by allowing time to source and fit components necessary to meet any new requirements of incoming rules.

All ANDRA stewards should make themselves familiar with the new rulebook which will be delivered to registered addresses during next week or shortly after.

Rules that have been published on the ANDRA website prior to the rulebook release should have allowed any affected competitors ample time to comply. This amnesty is to only cover the following listed items that are deemed to have high cost or availability issues that are likely to impact affected racers.

Only the following items will be granted an amnesty period up to 01 January 2013;

Clutch: Where a Crowerglide clutch is used it must have an over Centre neutral position that is Foot operated, no other option is acceptable.

Onboard Fire Suppression Systems: Any enclosed vehicle faster than 8.00 seconds (1/4 mile) or equivalent, From 01JAN2013, must have a serviceable fire suppression system of a minimum 5lb capacity (10lb recommended) installed unless specified otherwise by class regulations.

All other items listed in the 2013 Rulebook Changes will be enforced from the start of the 2013 season which officially commences on the 20th October 2013.
