RULEBOOK REFERENCE:

1.8.8 Divisional Champion Certificates

RULE SUBMISSION INTENT:

To reward racers who contest the national series from their division, no matter if they have someone else also competing from their division.

For instance in the case of Super Street racer Kylie Tanner from SA this season, she finished second nationally but was not rewarded with a certificate because no other SST racer from SA competed.

PROPOSED ADMENDMENT:

Delete “ A minimum of two nominations must be received in the division to be eligible for this award.”

CLASSES AFFECTED:

All sportsman categories.

Does this rule protect the safety of participants and spectators?

No impact on safety.

Is this rule a positive step for the sport?

Yes, as it rewards competitors for their commitment to a national series, especially those from divisions where not much racing may occur.

Is the impact of the rule on other classes and brackets a positive one?

It affects all sportsman categories equally.

Does the rule ensure increased opportunity for even competition?

There is no impact on the competition itself, only increased reward for the competitor at virtually no cost to ANDRA.

Is the rule practical and enforceable?

Yes, it in fact makes it easier to do the divisional champion certificates at the end of the year because there is no searching required to find if potential winners had other people from their division compete during the season.

Is the cost of complying with the rule reasonable for competitors?

No additional cost for competitors.
