RULE SUBMISSION INTENT:

The ICS unfairly disadvantages the smaller budget racer. It encourages “sandbagging” and gives no incentive for the cars in this class to “run what you brung” It is time consuming, particularly with indexes constantly having to be changed for individuals during race meetings and commentators trying to explain this complicated system, as well as a Committee that constantly has to monitor every race meeting.

PROPOSED ADMENDMENT:

The NSW DC recommends that the ICS be removed and all group 2 race to the National records.
