### ANDRA EVENT LEVELS

For further information regarding Event Levels and requirements for running ANDRA Sanctioned Events, please refer to your current ANDRA Drag Racing Event Levels document supplied to your track.

### 1 NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP and REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP

Open to all categories of vehicles provided for in the ANDRA Rules for Championship Drag Racing. National Championship events must post all ANDRA eliminations apart from Funny Car.

Ambulance: Full civil ambulance and safety facilities are compulsory

All entrants are required to hold a permanent ANDRA Drag Racing Licence at the Group One, Unlimited or Super Street levels, Licencing:

depending on class/performance levels

ANDRA PA Cover: ANDRA Personal Accident Insurance at the Category One level is compulsory for all participants, with the \$15.40 charge (inc

GST) being collected as part of the Entry Fee, and remitted to ANDRA within 28 days of the event

# 2. SPORTSMAN CHAMPIONSHIP

Open to all Sportsman Championship rounds only. With no group one or exhibition categories. Any group one category or exhibition attraction will require a regional championship sanction.

Ambulance: Full civil ambulance and safety facilities are compulsory

Licencing: Non ANDRA categories slower than S/ST cut-offs using a DDL allowed. All entrants in ANDRA championship category must hold

appropriate permanent licence for the class

ANDRA PA Cover: ANDRA Personal Accident Insurance at the Category One level is compulsory for all participants, and is extended to ANDRA

Members and holders of ANDRA Divisional Drag Racing Licences as part of their entry. The \$15.40 charge (inc GST) is collected

as part of the Entry Fee in all cases, and remitted to ANDRA within 28 days of the event

## 3. NATIONAL OPEN

Open to all categories of vehicles provided for in the ANDRA Rules for Championship Drag Racing Ambulance: Full civil ambulance and safety facilities are compulsory

Licencing: Apart from competitors whose vehicle performance requires an ANDRA Licence at the Unlimited or Group One level, all drivers or

riders must be current ANDRA Members, or hold a Divisional Drag Racing Licence, available on the day and current for the period

of the event

ANDRA PA Cover: ANDRA Personal Accident Insurance at the Category One level is compulsory for all participants, and is extended to ANDRA

Members and holders of ANDRA Divisional Drag Racing Licences as part of their entry. The \$15.40 charge (inc GST) is collected

as part of the Entry Fee in all cases, and remitted to ANDRA within 28 days of the event

Events conducted using the Group Three or Group Four handicap systems, with prize money and trophies at the organiser's discretion. One added bracket or match race may be featured as a special attraction, using vehicles from Top Bike, Pro Stock, or Pro Stock Motorcycle, or any other vehicles from Groups Two, Three or Four.

Ambulance: Full civil ambulance and safety facilities are compulsory

Apart from competitors whose vehicle performance requires an ANDRA Licence at the Unlimited or Group One level, all drivers or Licencing:

riders must be current ANDRA Members, or hold a Divisional Drag Racing Licence, available on the day and current for the period

of the event

ANDRA PA Cover: ANDRA Personal Accident Insurance at the Category One level is compulsory for all participants, and is extended to ANDRA

Members and holders of ANDRA Divisional Drag Racing Licences as part of their entry. The \$15.40 charge (inc GST) is collected

as part of the Entry Fee in all cases, and remitted to ANDRA within 28 days of the event

Show/display activities up to two days, promoted commercially incorporating competition or social driving activities. Exhibition permitted. ANDRA licence required for competition and burnout drivers.

Events catering for a bracket or "grudge" format only, with prize money and trophies at the organiser's discretion. No special attractions are permitted, and promotion of the event in this manner will result in its elevation to the Pro-Am level. There are three levels of Bracket events, based on entry numbers:

> BRACKET A (Comp) 91 entries or more

BRACKET A (Street) 91 entries or more - ROAD GOING CARS ONLY

**BRACKET B** 51 to 90 entries **BRACKET C** 30 to 50 entries **BRACKET D** Up to 30 entries

Ambulance and safety facilities are compulsory (refer ANDRA Drag Racing Event Levels document) Ambulance:

Apart from competitors whose vehicle performance requires an ANDRA Licence at the Unlimited or Group One level, all drivers or Licencing:

riders must be current ANDRA Members, or hold a Divisional Drag Racing Licence, available on the day and current for the period

of the event

ANDRA PA Cover: ANDRA Personal Accident Insurance at the Category Two level is provided automatically to holders of ANDRA permanent

licences, and ANDRA Members, and may be upgraded to Category One level on payment of the \$15.40 fee (inc GST) to the track or the senior ANDRA Steward on the day. Category Two cover will be extended to holders of Divisional Drag Racing licences, on payment of the \$5.00 fee (inc GST). Personal Accident collections should be remitted to ANDRA within 28 days of the event, along

with a full list of competitors and their residential addresses

# 7 TEST AND TUNE

For the purposes of performance testing or tuning only. May not be staged on temporary sites. **No paying spectators permitted.**Ambulance: Ambulance and safety facilities are **compulsory** (refer ANDRA Drag Racing Event Levels document)

Licencing: Divisional Drag Racing Licence (DDL) as a minimum

ANDRA PA Cover: ANDRA Personal Accident Insurance at the Category Two level is provided automatically to holders of permanent ANDRA

Licences. Category One cover is optional for holders of permanent ANDRA Licences, requiring the payment of the \$15.40 charge

(inc GST) to be remitted to ANDRA within 28 days of the event

# 8 DETERMINATION OF EVEN T LEVELS

The Pro-Am level and higher is intended for commercial, well-advertised and promoted events. The three levels of Bracket event and the Test and Tune meetings are accepted as those aimed at the competitors rather than the spectator attendance. The most common use of the Bracket level is the "off-street" meeting, whilst the Test and Tune event is intended as just the title implies. It is suitable for practice sessions or closed days for clubs. Of course, off-street events must be publicised in various ways to attract participants and these days we're seeing reasonable spectator interest at this level, but advertised "special features" are always intended to draw commercial numbers of spectators. The Bracket level of sanction states "No special attractions are permitted" and all events with advertised attractions should be subject to the Pro-Am fees or higher. Provision is made for the use of some special attractions at Pro-Am events, but the use of some Group One or any Exhibition vehicles requires sanction at the National (Open) level. This tends to affect the regional tracks as they often fall into the area between Bracket and Pro-Am. Any queries on Event Levels should be directed to the Chief Executive Officer in writing, together with details of any special attractions on this application form.
