



ANDRA Junior Competitor Finish Line Markers

Overview

Provides detail on appropriate markers to be used in distinctly marking the Junior Drag Racing 1/8-mile finish line at ANDRA sanctioned Drag Racing events.

Finish Line Markers

From 18th October 2019 it was recommended that any ANDRA Sanctioned venue that holds events including Junior Drag Racing; should mark the Junior Competitor 1/8-mile finish line in a distinct way other than the use of flags.

These recommendations became mandatory from 1st January 2020 for any ANDRA Sanctioned venue that holds events including Junior Drag Racing.

These distinct markers may be in the form of different colour or size foam markers as used for timing blocks, or similar markers as used by the NHRA, with appropriate mounting and material so as not to create any additional hazard. Other options for finish line markers are to paint the barrier in the area of the 1/8-mile finish line in a distinct way.

The 1/8-mile finish line markers for Junior Competitors should be used consistently when Junior Competitors are on track and form part of the track orientation for Junior Drag Racing.

On the following page are some examples using magnets and the foam used for timing system markers to designate the Junior Drag Racing 1/8-mile finish line.
