



## **ANDRA Junior Competitor Exiting Racing Surface**

### **Overview**

Provides detail on appropriate procedure to use for Junior Competitors when exiting the racing surface at ANDRA sanctioned Drag Racing events.

### **Exiting Racing Surface**

From 18th October 2019 it was recommended that any ANDRA Sanctioned venue that holds events including Junior Drag Racing, must have appropriate personnel to provide a person at the racing surface exit point for Junior Competitors.

From 18<sup>th</sup> October 2019 it was recommended that all Junior Competitors come to a complete stop at a pre-designated point (as stipulated in the Track Orientation). Once both competitors have come to a complete stop, they are to be directed off the surface by an Official to the return road at walking pace.

**These recommendations became mandatory from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2020 for any ANDRA Sanctioned venue that holds events including Junior Drag Racing.**

A painted line on the track or other marker on the barriers or track are suitable for indicating the desired stopping point, this will be explained in the Track Orientation.

Consistent hand signals or the use of “lollipop” stop/ slow signs are appropriate for Officials to signal to Junior Competitors.

The mandatory stopping for all Junior Competitors prior to exiting the racing surface should be introduced in line with the Track Orientation Processes.
