

For Three Round Format or Shootout Style Format - When there are four (4) or less competitors, the event winner receives 80 points, runner up receives 60 points, and the other competitor/s receive 40 points each if they present* for any round of racing under the Three Round Format or Shootout Style Format. The points detailed in the Three Round Format (Group 1) table do not apply to ANDRA Sportsman Championship brackets / classes.

For Elimination Format - If there are five (5) to seven (7) qualifiers, 20 points will be awarded to all competitors who present* for the first round of racing.

For Elimination Format - If there are eight (8) qualifiers, 40 points will be awarded to all competitors who present* for the first round of racing.

For Elimination Format - If there are nine (9) to sixteen (16) qualifiers, 20 points will be awarded to all competitors who present* for the first round of racing.

For Elimination Format - If there are sixteen (16) or more qualifiers, 10 points will be awarded to all competitors who present* for the first round of racing.

* In all scenarios above, "present" means the vehicle's engine must start and the vehicle must Stage under its own engine power when directed by The Starter. If the vehicle's engine cannot be started and/or the vehicle cannot Stage under its own engine power for Round 1, then zero points will be allocated to that competitor.

ANDRA Sportsman Championship competitors competing in Elimination rounds will be awarded points as per the points structure below.

At ANDRA Sportsman Championship rounds Groups 2, 3, and 4 may be run as per the Group One Three Round Format racing or Shootout Style Format racing at the discretion of the Meeting Director.

Shootout Style Format Points Allocation:

Points will be allocated on the basis of 20 points for round win and 10 points for a round loss. The highest points scorers from the three racing rounds compete in a final, deciding the winner and runner up.

For Handicap and Index Racing - Where more than two competitors are tied on points after 3 rounds the tie breaker will be best performance against the Handicap/Index in Round 3, which results in a Round 3 win. Second tie breaker will be best performance against the Handicap/Index in Round 2, which results in a Round 2 win.

For Dial Your Own Racing - Where more than two competitors are tied on points after three rounds the tie breaker will be the Best Package* in Round 3, which results in a Round 3 win. Second tie breaker will be the Best Package* in Round 2, which results in a Round 2 win.

In situations where a competitor is making a solo run in Round 3, they are considered the automatic winner once they stage and receive the green light, regardless of a Break Out and/or a red light.

* Best Package means the competitor's reaction time plus the deviation from the dial-in.
