

<b>POLICY TITLE</b>	ANDRA Passenger Policy
<b>PURPOSE</b>	Minimum Requirements to Conduct Passenger Rides
<b>REVIEWED</b>	July 2025
<b>REVIEW FREQUENCY</b>	Annually
<b>RESPONSIBLE</b>	ANDRA

### CRITERIA

A single passenger (unless otherwise specified) may be carried in Drag Racing vehicles subject to the following conditions.

- Ambulance and fire crews must be present.
- Prior to the activity, passengers should be briefed on safety and procedural aspects by the organiser and be required to complete the ANDRA Acknowledgement of Risk Statement.
- In all cases the physical stature of the passenger must be compatible with seating /harness provisions. Medical advice / permission should be sought for passengers over 75 years of age, or any passenger where health may be an issue.
- The passenger/passengers must be afforded the same measure of protection afforded by the driver under the ANDRA regulations relevant to the vehicle.
- The driver must be familiar and experienced in the vehicle (cannot be first time participants in that particular vehicle) and hold the appropriate ANDRA credentials and the passenger must hold an appropriate ANDRA Membership / Licence or ANDRA Day Licence as a minimum.
- Paired passes are permitted at any time during off street type events, with an elapsed time of 10.50secs (1/4 mile) / 6.68secs (1/8 mile), or slower, or in the case of Modern\* Street Cars, with an elapsed time of 10.00 (1/4 mile) / 6.36secs (1/8 mile), or slower.
- Paired passes, as per the above section are permitted during higher level events where the passes are not run during competition, and form exhibition or promotional activities.
- Vehicles quicker than 10.50secs (1/4 mile) / 6.68secs (1/8 mile), or 10.00secs (1/4 mile) / 6.36secs (1/8 mile) in the case of Modern\* Street Cars, are restricted to solo passes unless specific approval from ANDRA is provided.
- Vehicles quicker than the above section require specific ANDRA approval prior to the permit being issued and the activity taking place and are restricted to 7.50secs (1/4 mile) / 4.77secs (1/8 mile) or slower and may not exceed 180mph (290kph).
- Any vehicle with an elapsed time slower than 7.50secs (1/4 mile) / 4.77secs (1/8 mile) can partake in passenger activities if all minimum requirements as per the current ANDRA Rulebook are met for the vehicle type and vehicle performance.
- Rear Engine Dragster type vehicles, with passenger/passengers location rearward of the driver, must hold a current and relevant vehicle logbook and be pre-approved to carry one passenger by ANDRA and will be limited to 7.50secs (1/4 mile) / 4.77secs (1/8 mile), and a maximum speed of 180mph (290kph).
- No vehicle carrying passengers may exceed 180 mph (290kph).
- Regardless of ANDRA Extended Scrutineering Program provisions, the vehicle must be scrutineered with specific checks made on safety measures with the passenger in place, by an approved official, and an "OK to carry a passenger" identification marking being applied.
- Minimum age for passengers is 16 years of age, and in cases where the passenger is less than 18 years of age, the relevant Disclaimer and Consent Statement for Persons Under the age of 18 years form must be completed.
- Where the passenger activity is a prize for a raffle competition, winners should be advised before any public announcement is made and should be given the opportunity to decline.
- Where the activity is to be conducted on a commercial basis an annual Licencing Fee will be payable to ANDRA.

### NOTES

**ANDRA must be notified prior to the event to ensure that this vehicle Passenger Policy is complied with.**

**Long-term commercially based activities require approval from ANDRA. All approvals will be subject to the above listed clauses. Individual activities will require approval in writing from ANDRA prior to the activity taking place. Approval may be either on an individual basis or an annual basis where more appropriate.**
